I owned a houseboat there for 30 years owned two single and one double gun punts and was a voluntary warden working on the estuary for over twenty years. Great Yarmouth Wildfowling and Conservation Association were behind the move to have Breydon Water made into Norfolk's first LNR, (localnature reserve) in 1968 and are still involved in running parts of the reserve today, and are responsible for wildfowling management on all of the reserve.
