# **PUBLIC SAFETY**

Proposals to ban access of under 18 year olds

to firearms will damage training in safe and responsible use.

Proposals to restrict licence length could block UK moves to free up resources and improve public safety by introducing 10 year licences.

### FOOD SECURITY



Proposals to extend the ban on semiautomatic rifles will harm pest control – the .22 rimfire semi auto is the preferred rifle for rabbit control – with knock on effects on farm incomes and food prices.

## **RESTRICTING TRADE**

Proposals on advertising and sales will damage the legally controlled sale and purchase of firearms across the UK.

## **WORKING DOGS**



Proposed controls on guns using blanks will negatively affect training for working gun dogs.

The UK has some of the toughest firearms laws in the world and is widely seen as a role model by other countries and international commentators. The Commission proposals put

the UK model of firearms regulations at risk from unintended consequences and must be amended.
